## After School Arts Program

**DESCRIPTION:** The Plaza Community Center After School Art Program (ASAP) begins again in September on Tuesdays from 3:15–5:15 PM. Children K - 8th grade are invited to attend once a month per the schedule listed here. Every student will receive a healthy snack when they arrive. We divide everyone into groups and rotate among different arts and crafts activities. In 2018, we had 155 kids registered for this FREE after school program!

**THIS IS A FREE PROGRAM BUT STUDENTS MUST BE REGISTERED TO ATTEND.**

**TRANSPORTATION:** After school, Putnam County students may take a school bus directly to The Plaza Community Center. *\*Separate form required to set up bus transportation schedule!* Transportation for private school and home schooled children must be arranged by parents. ALL students will need to be picked up at The Plaza Community Center at 5:15 PM by a family member.

**LOCATION:** The Plaza Community Center is located directly behind The Plaza Arts Center at 100 Ulysses Rice Court, located directly off Church Street just past the library parking lot entrance.

## Video Production and Editing Class

**This class is open to middle school & high school students - limited to 20 students.**

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** Students will learn about video production and video editing in this hands-on class. Each participant will have use of a camera to learn the steps necessary to produce different types of videos. This course will teach the basics skills of video production including writing a script, creating a storyboard, shooting videos, and editing videos. Instructor Maurice Hill, Putnam County Charter Schools' Facilities Manager, is a former freelance videographer and has a variety of video and editing equipment for students to use.

**DATES:** Class runs every Thursday from 4:00 - 6:00 PM for 6 weeks, beginning October 3, 2019.

**COST:** FREE; however, students must be registered to attend.
